

1 ABOUT US

How it all began and where we want to go...

OUR NORTHSTAR

We want to support children and women in Vietnam to lead a self-determined life by providing food, security, and education. Therefore we support basic needs such as security and education first. In the future, we want to support more advanced needs, such as higher education and mental encouragement as well as companionship. In this way, we would like to give them a "chance to grow".

THE BEGINNING

Chance to Grow e.V. is a registered non-profit association based in Frankfurt am Main. The association exists since 2010 and, thanks to our donors, has been able to give vital help and hope to children in Vietnam in numerous campaigns. We started with three volunteers and have been growing ever since.







OUR THREE COLUMNS





Charity

We help children in disasters and situations of need with food, safety, and education. In this way, we give hope to the youngest and create the essential conditions for a self-determined life.

Community

We are employees, employers, retirees, students, Buddhists, Christians, Muslims, women, and men of all ages and from different countries. In short: people who want to do something meaningful for others in addition to their everyday lives.

Bridge to Vietnam

We are a bridge to Vietnam. We offer a kind of platform and exchange point for those who want this connection. Be it because of their own origin or interest in the country.



How we help and stay tuned

TRANSPARENCY

We work with several partner organizations in Vietnam, e.g. a Buddhist organization led by a nun, which gives us suggestions for concrete aid measures, for example after natural disasters.

We review these and decide on projects that are worthy of support. Our four-person finance team supports our transparency and oversight.

Both the disbursement and the implementation are personally supervised by local staff and we check the results. We check, for example, whether a sponsored child later goes to school.

All disbursements are confirmed by at least two people. In addition, we report to the German tax office and our donors in detail about the use of funds. Our aim is to use 100% of private donations for the projects – without operating costs, so we all work voluntarily. Costs with partners are usually limited to 20%, which is very little in Vietnam.



We accompany the sponsored children and see to it that we can help in the long term and sustainably. Money alone does not change anything. Much more we support so that children can feel safe, have enough to eat and receive education, also operations and materials to lead as good a self-determined life as possible.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Cost control and no unnecessary expenses. We report very extensively and detailed on our social media channels about our projects.
- No unnecessary administrative costs
- Double certainty with every booking: Everything is controlled and reported.



2 OUR PROGRAMS

Our two main programs are the microcredit program for women and the sponsorship program, which enables children from poor backgrounds to go to school. In this way, we support the UN Sustainable Development Goals of providing access to education and contribute to gender equality.

Microcredits

What is the microcredit program?

Together with our partner, Bong Sen, we aim to support single mothers in Vietnam liveing in poverty. With the microcredit program, we give them a chance to stand on their own feet.

Our program includes an interestfree loan that is paid out in monthly checks, health insurance and training to provide the women with the knowledge they need. The focus of the training is on agriculture and the proper handling of their finances. This knowledge will help the women cultivating their fields, which will enable them to earn their living and escape poverty.

The goal of our program is to help single mothers and women lead self-determined lives while giving their children the opportunity to attend school.

What is the composition of the program and what has been achieved so far?

In total, one household received a credit of 5,875 euros, which was provided to them within the 12-month term. The cost of health insurance was 2,405 euros per household.

So far, about 50 households have been included in our program. Through our help, all households were able to fully pay off their debts on time.



Microcredits

The contracts with the respective households expired in September and new contracts have already been concluded.

What are the next steps?

Our partners from Bong Sen are trying to find more households that would be willing to participate in the program. Our task is to find further strategies to increase and support the budget for the project.

Sponsorship Program

In the sponsorship project we cooperate with the Youth Union and the Department of Education in Ga Lai Province to give children the chance to complete a school education.

Every child who is of school age qualifies for the project and is supported by us and the sponsors until the age of 18.







Sponsorship Program

What is the composition of the program and what has been achieved so far?

For the project, each child gets 15€, monthly paid by sponsors and our donations. From this, 2€ goes to administrative costs and 13€ is used for school fees, food and other necessities as well as financial support for the families if needed.

With the help of our organization, contact between the child and the sponsors is made possible. This is done in the form of e-mails, newsletters, or through exchanges of letters.

What are the next steps?

For the following year, we plan to find more regular sponsors, as well as start more fundraisers to increase our budget for the project so that each child receives enough supplies over the years. Other goals also include adding more children to the project and possibly expanding our reach.



4 HIGHLIGHTS 2021

Projects during Vietnamese Lunar New Year "Tết"

Tết Gifts in Quang Binh (Jan. 16 and 17)

This is a personal project of our CtG member Ella, for which she collected donations on her birthday in her circle of friends and at CtG. Chance To Grow supported her with logistics and transport.



The supported children belong to the Bru community – an ethnic minority living in the border area between Vietnam and Laos. The nearest town is 90 km away and their village is very remote.

Due to the remote location, access to higher education is non-existent, clean water is limited and infrastructure is barely developed. In addition, the winter months in the mountains are very cold. So we were able to support them with warm clothes. 200 jackets were distributed to 200 children from this community.

This was Ella's third trip as Chance To Grow's project manager to Quang Binh province.





Tết Gifts in Gia Lai (Jan. 30 and 31)

Gia Lai is a highland province, 500 km northeast of Ho Chi Minh. In Chu Se district – an area of 1,310 km2 – 136,464 people from different ethnic groups such as Gia Rai, Ba Na, and Kinh live together. 50% of the population lives from simple agriculture. (CtG is running a scholarship program here to support 70 children from very disadvantaged families so they can continue to go to school and get a higher education).

On the occasion of Tet Festival, Chance To Grow distributed 1755 kg of rice to 117 families and 5 bicycles to 5 students, wishing them and their families a happy Tet Festival!





Project "Flood Resistant Homes"

In the project "Flood Resistance Homes", we try to build or optimize houses against any kind of natural disaster or other catastrophes resulting from climate changes. As a result of this, in the case of flooding, houses should dislocate themselves without taking any damage.

Up until now, with the help of our partner, the Song Foundation, we could reinforce three houses against natural disasters. Our focus lies in the Nam Tra My district, Quang Nam province, Bac Tra My province and Quang Nam province.



Project "Forest Symphony"

The Forest Symphony project focuses on the Ninh Thuan region, where we aim to increase forest density through new plantings. Diverse tree species are planted for this purpose on the rocky mountains of the region to maximize the functions of forests in protecting watersheds, securing freshwater sources for daily life and sustainable socio–economic development. So far, with the help from Song Foundation, we have been able to plant over 1,160 new trees.

Why in the Ninh Thuan region?

Ninh Thuan province is located in the southernmost region of central Vietnam. Due to its geographical location and topography, Ninh Thuan is frequently affected by climate change and its extreme natural disasters such as drought, desertification, dry heat, flash floods. In 2020 alone, this caused damages of VND 73,951 million.

Goal of the "Forest Symphony" project

The main goal of the project and the top priority of the authorities is to limit the impact of climate change in Ninh Thuan region. In addition, we want to create a higher awareness of the importance of the forest and its sustainable development as well as the consequences of climate change and actively involve the community in forest reforestation. This will lead to job creation as well as higher income for those who depend on the forest.

At the same time, the locally typical and unique species of Vietnam's arid regions will be preserved.





Baby Lam

In spring we started a big fundraising campaign to help Baby Lam and her family. The money was for an urgently needed heart surgery.

To cover all costs and to help the family to get a stable income, a total of 2.215 € was needed. Together with all of you, we even exceeded our goal and raised 4.585,19 €. We have therefore decided to share the surplus among other needy families from our microcredit program.



COVID Action

In the summer, the Corona crisis and the newly emerged Delta variant hit Vietnam hard, overwhelming the country with a fourth wave.

With your support we were able to raise over 6,500€ and send it to our partner organization Song Foundation. With their "Stay Strong Vietnam" campaign, the donations were used to buy N95 masks, medical gloves and machines like the HFNC.

Our Plans for 2022

Transparency

In 2022, we plan to further improve our communication and structure. This means: more reports, detailed presentation of our work and our projects to donors, media and our members. For us, the focus is clearly on the following: We are all volunteers, but the cooperation should become better and better and successes should be visible more quickly.
